Assemblywoman Mila M. Jasey (D-Essex) will take part in a panel discussion at the White House on Monday billed as the “Forum on First Suburbs, Inclusion, Sustainability and Economic Growth.”

Jasey is one of a group of 140 municipal, business and community leaders from around the country who have been invited to participate in the forum.

The event is co-hosted by the White House, the New Jersey Regional Coalition and Building One America. Topics are expected to include sustainability, inclusion and economic growth.
